To control *how* a concept is stored on the clipboard, use the Options menu. Here you choose to export only the alphanumeric notation **46B13** or combine it with the concept definition **shop, store**. Here you may also set the Iconclass system language of your preference, which then automatically becomes the language of the definition on the clipboard.

It is also possible to copy more than one notation to a clipboard, but then you need to create your own [personal Iconclass Clipboard](#)
