Step 3:

Having clicked on Edit, you will see this screen where you may actually edit the concept definition ('textual correlate'), which now reads [political parties](#).

You can do so in English and in the other available languages.

You can also edit the [Keywords](#) that help you find the concept, arrange the order in which the [Children](#) (narrower terms) are listed, and add [Systematic References](#), i.e. create cross-links to other Iconclass concepts.

Step 4:

Actually editing the concept properties. Here a new 'Systematic Reference' is added to the concept **44C33 political parties**.

Adding this Systematic References will result in a permanent cross-link from the concept of *political parties* to:

Clicking the '*under revision*' flag will reveal the proposed change, in this case the cross-reference that is shown immediately below the concept definition and its keyword (the words in italics).

As it is very unlikely that an added cross-reference will be the subject of fierce debate, edits like these are usually incorporated in the regular schedules without much delay, so the flag will quickly disappear.
